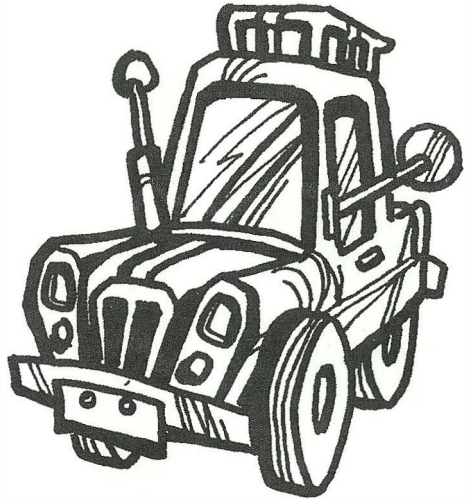


3. PARKING LOT
